

Observation Experience Objectives

The Observation Experience allows students who are interested in many areas within healthcare to get an idea of the role by allowing them to directly observe a department or individual for several hours with the exception of the Emergency Room, Birthing Center and Surgical Services. The intention or goal of an observation should be to educate the student on the roles and responsibilities of the departments and or role. Students must be 9th grade or higher to participate.

At the end of the Observation Experience, the participant will be able to:

- 1. Identify the types of services provided in a rural hospital
- 2. Understand the basic education preparation required for the careers discussed.
- 3. Understand some of the skills needed for the careers discussed.
