# Tuition Scholarship Rules 2024

#### To Apply:

**Tuition:** You must be a previous Door County High School (Gibraltar, Sevastopol, Southern Door, Sturgeon Bay, Washington Island, and Algoma HS) graduate continuing your education in the medical field **OR** 

**Employee:** Current DCMC Employee continuing your education in the medical field working 20 hours or more per week.

### **Process for submitting forms:**

- **a.** Applicant must print and complete all parts of the online Tuition Scholarship Application: **Tuition Forms A and C.**
- Applicant must return completed Tuition Forms A and C, College Acceptance Letter for new applicants only, College Transcript (certified copy not required) and (2) Current Letters of Recommendation.

**Application deadline is April 1, 2024 –** Applications that are incomplete or received after April 1, 2024 will not be considered.

### Awarding of Scholarships will be based on the following criteria:

- a. Applicant must be planning to pursue a full course of studies toward an undergraduate degree, graduate degree, or higher education at an accredited technical school, 4-year college or university in the medical field OR a DCMC Employee continuing your education in the medical field working 20 hours or more per week.
- b. Current Letters of Recommendation.
- c. Award winners must have maintained a 3.0 or better GPA (based on a 4.0 system)

#### Notification of award and presentation:

- Awarding of scholarships under this program will be the sole responsibility of the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee along with the cooperation and assistance of certain school personnel. All applications will be considered without regard to the applicant's age, sex, race religion, handicap or other protected categories.
- Recipients will be notified by May 31, 2024
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to the Applicant (including the school name).
